## SARAJEVO

### sarajevo film festival...

The Sarajevo Film Festival was founded in 1995, during the siege of Sarajevo and it became the symbol of resistance and protection of cultural values. Today it is the leading film festival in the region, recognized by both film professionals and the wider audience. It is a must-see event.



## SARAJEVO

### jazz fest...

It is an international festival which takes place annually, in the first week of November. The festival gathers well known musicians from around the globe and since its founding in 1997 until today, it hosted hundreds of artists from more than 60 countries.

### ilidža music fest...

The Ilidža Folk Music Festival, traditionally held in July, is the oldest and most prestigious festival of folk music in former Yugoslavia. Some of the greatest hits of the folk music were created for this manifestation. The festival still nurtures the true folk song, very similar to "sevdalinka".



## SARAJEVO

### sarajevo holiday market...

The Sarajevo Holiday Market offers visitors of all generations a wealth of cultural, sports, and entertainment events. Within the market there is also a trade fair with handicraft products, clothing and jewellery shops, as well as a rich music program.

### bašćaršija nights...

This summer festival of culture offers its visitors rich program that includes ballet, opera and theatre performances, concerts, literary evenings... The festival takes place during the month of July and admission is free.

### sarajevo winter...

The Sarajevo Winter Festival is one of the most significant Sarajevo cultural festivals held every year during February and March. The program includes theatre shows, concerts, films, exhibitions, panel discussions, children's program, and activities aimed at presenting and preserving the cultural heritage.

### mess...

The International Theatre Festival MESS is the most prominent theatre festival in Southeast Europe. It was formed in 1960 and was held even during the siege of Sarajevo. Among their many other performances, the festival team put on the cult show "Waiting for Godot", directed by Susan Sontag in 1993, in Sarajevo.

### sarajevo derby...

The Sarajevo Derby or "Eternal Derby" represents football matches between the two city rivals, FK Sarajevo and FK Željezničar. These are the two largest and most popular clubs in Bosnia and Herzegovina. It is believed that this match is one of the most atmospheric football derbies in Europe.
