yellow Fortress...

The Fortress was built during the Ottoman period. This fortification is located on the elevation in the old part of town and it offers one of the most beautiful views of Saraievo. During the Muslim month of Ramadan this is a spot where a cannon is fired at sunset to mark the time for breaking the fast.

white fortress...

This National Monument of Bosnia and Herzegovina is situated atop a hill and offers a fantastic view of the city and its surroundings. It is one of the five fortifications that were built as part of the defensive wall around the Old Town Vratnik.














old_jewish cemetery...

It is located in the footbills of Mount Trebević, in the southwestern part of Sarajevo called Kovačići and Debelo Brdo. This is known as the second largest Jewish cemetery in Europe, after the one in Prag. The oldest preserved tombstone dates from 1630 and the cementery was in use until 1966.

viewpoint trebević...

This is one of the most popular excursion sites for Sarajevans. Until 1992 it was possible to reach Vidikovac by the famous city's cable car that was destroyed during the siege of Sarajevo. The cable car is currently being reconstructed and expected to be back in operation in April 2018.











avaz twist Tower...

With its staggering height of 175m, this is by far the tallest building in Sarajevo and one of the tallest in the Balkans. There is a magnificent view from the top of the Tower reachable by the super fast panoramic elevators.

vralnik...

Vratnik is a settlement in Sarajevo located above Baščaršija. This, once fortified city "Stari grad Vratnik", was built in the 18th century and thanks to its old architecture and beautiful view of Sarajevo represents an important tourist attraction of the city.













bistuk_

This is one of the oldest settlements of Sarajevo which dates back to the middle of the 15th century. Walking up the main Bistrik road, surpassing some of the old Bosnian houses, you will finally reach the old railway station Bistrik from where stunning view awaits you.









zmajevae...

This is one of the most popular vantage points of Sarajevo. It offers a spectacular view of the city and its surrounding hills and mountains. This beautiful point can be reached by a steep walk trough the street of the Vratnik neighbourhood or by public transport-bus or taxi.
